club administration. The new club format gives this dynamic group the opportunity to socialize and serve with men and women with similar interests and within the same age group.

New Century Clubs give community-minded adults through age 35 the ability to:

- Choose service activities that are relevant to club members and the community
- Have a flexible meeting schedule that fits members' busy lifestyles
- Manage the club with fewer administrative requirements
- Use the Internet to ease club administration

Members of New Century Lions Clubs have the same rights, privileges and responsibilities common to all Lions club members.

To Charter a New Century Lions Club you will need:

- 20 or more charter members
- a sponsoring club, district cabinet or district committee
- your district governor's approval
- completed charter application

During the club's first 7 years, only adults through age 35 may be invited to join. Members may continue membership after age 35. After 7 years, the club can recruit community-minded adults of any age.

If you are unable to recruit 20 quality members, consider forming a New Century club branch.

New Century, New Look



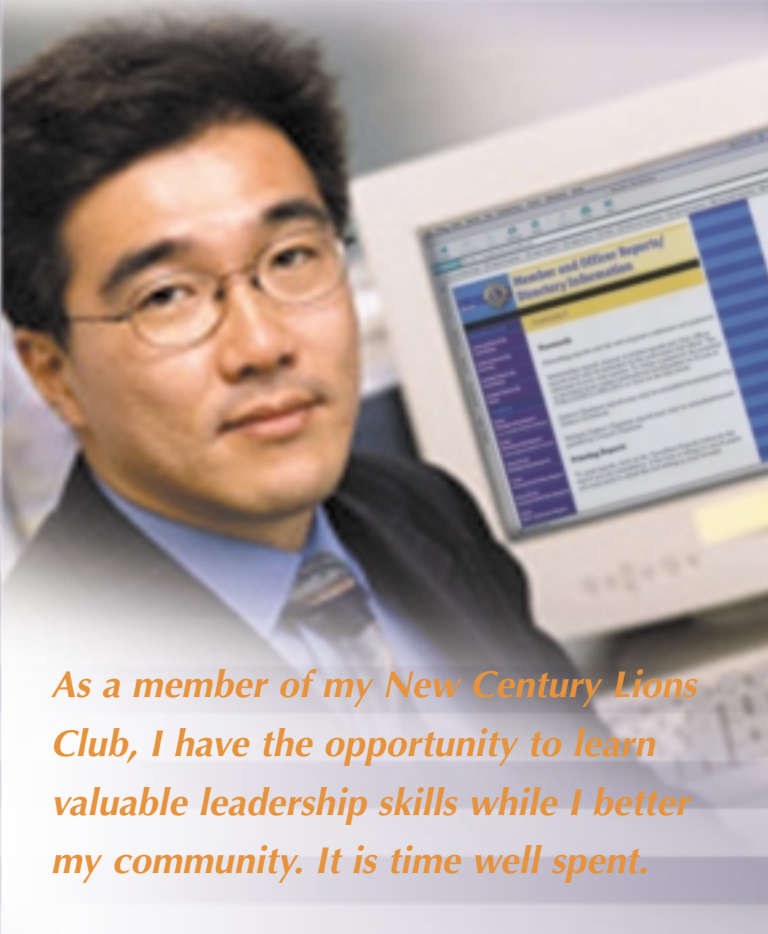
New Century Lions Clubs have a bold new look! The special logo features a sunrise signifying the dawn of a new era and all the promise the new millennium holds.
